Pursuant to Section 12(g) of Executive Order No. 125/125-A which mandates the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA) to undertake the assessment of competence and issuance of license to qualified domestic seafarers and MARINA Memorandum Circulars No. MD-2020-01, No. MD-2020-03 and No. MD-2020-07, **this Authority is pleased to announce that it is now accepting applicants for three (3) slots of Panel of Examiners for Engine Department**, with the following qualifications:

1. Must be a Filipino citizen;
2. Physically and Mentally fit;
3. Duly licensed Chief Engineer/Second/Third or Fourth Engineer;
4. Must have three (3) years' experience as Chief/Second/Third or Fourth Engineer;
5. Completed the IMO Model Course 6.09 (Training Course for Instructors) and 3.12 (Training Course for Assessors); and,
6. Of good moral character.

The following are the duties and responsibilities of the Members of the Panel of Examiners pursuant to MARINA Circular 2012-03:

1. Formulate examination questions including the answers for submission to the MARINA on a quarterly basis.
2. Formulate the procedures in the conduct of written and oral examination for applicants of Marine Diesel Mechanic 2 and 1 and Motorman, as appropriate;
3. Check the answer sheets of the examinees;
4. Prepare a report of the completed results of the examination;
5. Supervise the Pool of Assessors in the conduct of Oral Examination; and
6. Attend meeting/s organized by the MARINA Administrator or Chairman of the Panels.


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Applicants are required to submit the following documentary requirements:

- Curriculum Vitae with all documents attesting the data reflected therein, attached;
- Medical Certificate issued by a DOH-accredited medical clinic valid for one (1) year;
- COC or License as Chief Engineer/Second/Third or Fourth Engineer;
- Pertinent pages of SIRB/SRB or Certificate of Sea Service;
- Certificate of Training Completion of IMO Model Course 6.09 and 3.12; and,
- Valid NBI Clearance.
