
**SUBJECT :** RESTRICTION ON THE UTILIZATION OF NON-OPERATIONAL  
VESSELS AS TRAINING VESSELS AND ONBOARD SIMULATION  
FACILITY

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Presidential Degree No. 474, Sec. 14(e) of E.O. No. 125/125A and Sec. 9, Chapter III of R.A. No. 9295, that all concerned Domestic Shipping Companies/Operators/Charterers and Maritime Training Institutions are hereby directed to ensure that all vessels without a functioning propulsion system, navigational system, steering and machinery components, fire detection and fire suppression system and other operational components onboard are prohibited from being utilized as Training Ship and/or Onboard Simulation Facility.

This is to ensure that the implementation of Onboard Training (OBT) for Cadets on Philippine-registered ships, through the MARINA MC SC 2022-01 "GUIDELINES FOR ONBOARD TRAINING OF CADETS ON PHILIPPINE REGISTERED SHIPS ENGAGED IN THE DOMESTIC SHIPPING" will be correctly promulgated to set specific guidelines in ensuring a structured and practical training approach to all Philippine-registered Shipping Companies who are currently accommodating cadets for onboard shipboard training
