TO ALL SHIPOWNERS/OPERATORS OF PHILIPPINE REGISTERED VESSELS (PRVs) ENGAGED IN INTERNATIONAL VOYAGES/OPERATIONS AND ALL CONCERNED

SUBJECT : REITERATION OF THE STRICT COMPLIANCE TO THE CONVENTION ON THE INTERNATIONAL REGULATION FOR PREVENTING COLLISION AT SEA, 1972 (COLREGs) AND OBSERVANCE OF TRAFFIC SEPARATION SCHEME (TSS), INSHORE TRAFFIC ZONE AND MANDATORY REPORTING REQUIREMENTS WHILE TRANSITING THE DOVER STRAIT AND OTHER NAVIGATIONAL AREAS WITH TSS

In line with the declared policy of this Authority on the safety of ships and their operations and in accordance with its mandates as flag Administration under Presidential Decree No. 474 and Executive Order No. 125, as amended, **NOTICE** is hereby given to all Philippine Registered Vessels to strictly observe the Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS), Inshore Traffic Zone and mandatory reporting requirements while transiting the Dover Strait and other navigational areas with TSS.

Likewise, it is hereby reiterated that all Masters and Officers of the Watch (OOW) are reminded to comply with the relevant regulation requirements of the Convention on the International Regulation for Preventing Collision at Sea, 1972 (COLREGs) and its subsequent amendments and related IMO Circulars and issuances.
