



# MARITIME INDUSTRY AUTHORITY SITUATION REPORT -1213

Passenger and Cargo Shipping Operations on 7/19/2023  
in areas under Alert Level 1 & 2

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Fifty Seven percent (57%) of passenger and cargo shipping operations were completed in accordance with the ships' CPC.
- Forty-Three (43%) of the shipping operations were affected.
- Operations of passenger ships were more affected compared to cargo ships. 100% of the cargo shipping operations were completed under normal conditions compared to passenger ships at 40%.
- **With cargo shipping still operational, transport of goods is assured.**

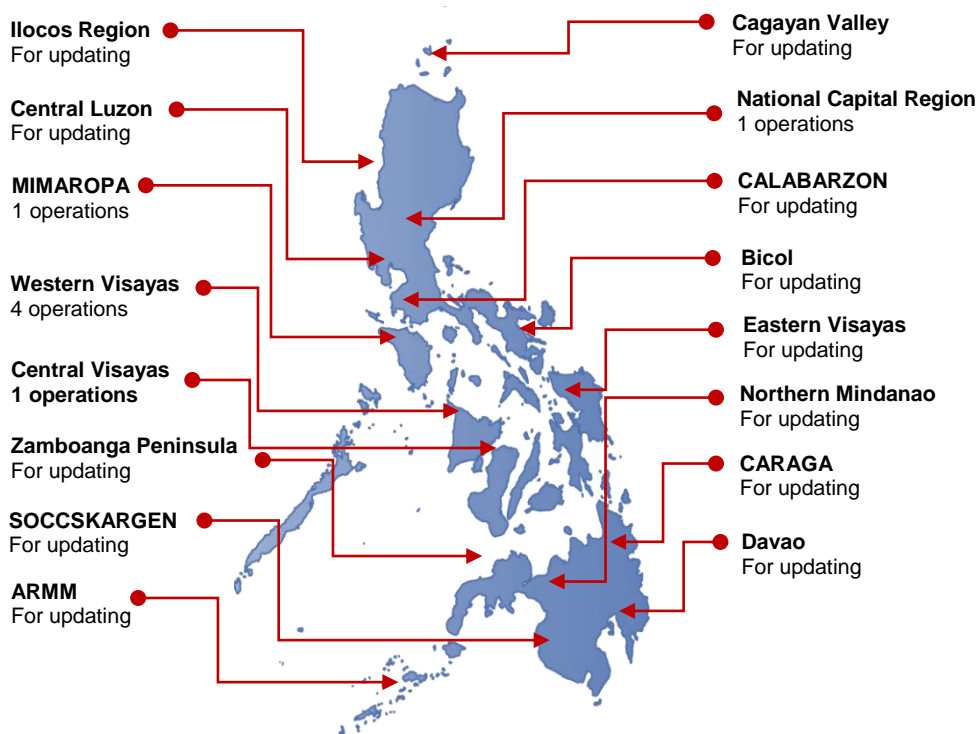

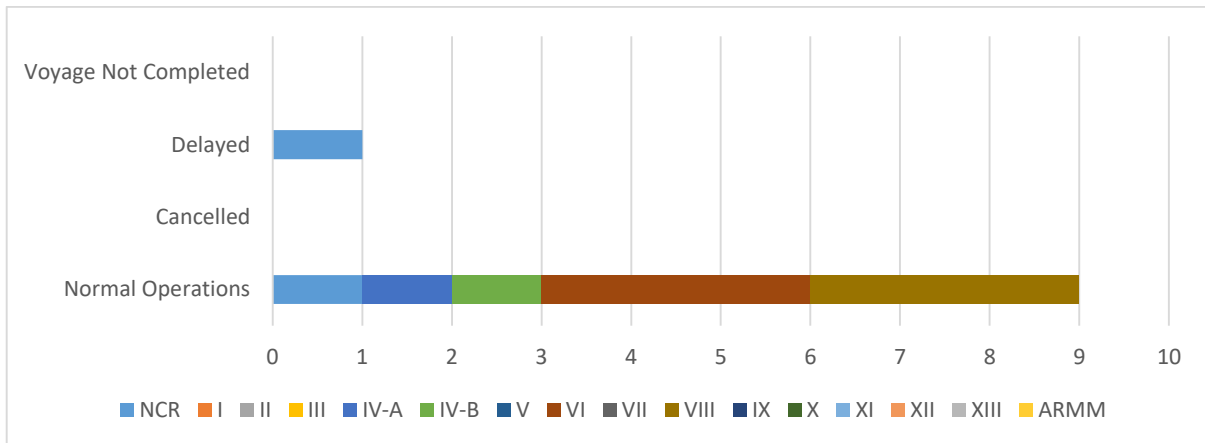

## I. STATUS OF SHIPPING OPERATIONS NATIONWIDE



On 7/19/2023, there were 7 passenger and cargo shipping operations conducted wherein 4 or 57% were completed in accordance with their Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC).

Out of the 4 operations completed under normal conditions, the reported movements were mostly in the Western Visayas Region at 50% and Eastern Visayas Region at 25%.

Three (3) passenger ships or 60% encountered delays.

No shipping operations were not completed at the time of reporting.

Based on the above table , 2 out of 2 (100%) cargo ships still operated normally – are 2 container ships.

(2) passenger ships completed their voyage – 2 RoPax ships completed their operations but mostly only carried cargoes during their voyage.

Meanwhile out of the 5 passenger ships, 60% were affected by the measures adopted in view of COVID-19. These measures caused either the cancellation, delay, or uncompleted operations of 3 passenger ships.
