- 1. Bidders shall provide correct and accurate information required in this form.
- 2. Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by you or any of your duly authorized representative/s.
- 3. Price quotation/s must be valid for a period of FORTY-FIVE (45) calendar days from the date of submission.
- 4. Price quotation/s, to be denominated in Philippine peso shall include all taxes, duties and/or levies payable.
- 5. Quotations exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.
- 6. In case of two or more bidders are determined to have submitted the Lowest Calculated Quotation/Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation, the MARINA shall adopt and employ "draw lots" as the tie-breaking method to finally determine the single winning provider in accordance with GPPB Circular 06-2005.
- Award of contract shall be made to the lowest quotation which complies with the technical specifications, requirements and other terms and conditions stated herein.
- 8. The item/s shall be delivered according to the accepted offer of the bidder.
- Item/s delivered shall be inspected on the scheduled date and time of the MARINA. The delivery of the item/s shall be acknowledged upon the delivery to confirm the compliance with the technical specifications.
- 10. Payment shall be made after delivery and upon the submission of the required supporting documents, i.e. Order Slip and/or Billing Statement, by the supplier, contractor, or consultant. I. BACKGROUND

The Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA), a government agency established pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 474 (1974) and attached to the Department of Transportation (DOTr), wishes to engage qualified bands to perform live during the MARINA's 50th Founding Anniversary celebration which will be held on 01 June 2024 at the Okada Manila located at New Seaside Dr, Entertainment City, Parañaque, 1701, Maynila

II. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this Terms of Reference (TOR) is to solicit proposals from qualified live band performers during the MARINA's 50th Founding Anniversary celebration. Service will be provided based on the terms and conditions stipulated in this TOR.

III. APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT

The Approved Budget of the Contract (ABC) is **Seventy Thousand Pesos** (**P70,000.00**) inclusive of VAT, which will be charged against the MARINA Central Office funds FY 2024. The ABC includes all expenses related to the performance, including musicians' fees, transportation, equipment rental, and any other associated costs.
