SUBJECT : EXTENSION OF VALIDITY OF EXISTING SPECIAL PERMITS (SPs) ISSUED UNDER MC NO. 2011-04 FOR THE TEMPORARY UTILIZATION OF FOREIGN-REGISTERED SHIPS WITHIN THE NATIONAL TERRITORY.

In the best interest of the service and to effectively cope with the robust investment climate in the country resulting to an influx of specialized foreign vessels operating on numerous government-approved projects, the validity of existing Special Permits (SPs) issued under MC No. 2011-04 for the temporary utilization of foreign-registered ships within the national territory shall be extended subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Contract showing that the duration of the government project for which the ship is being utilized is more than two (2) years;
- 2. That the grant of the extension of the SP is subject to annual inspection/survey by this Authority;
- 3. That the processing fee for the grant of the extension of the SP regardless of the type of ship involved is Php600,000.00 minimum/month/ship or Php1,200.00/50 GRT or fraction thereof, whichever is higher, based on the processing fee provided under MARINA Circular No. 2017-02; and
- 4. That this Advisory will apply exclusively to SP issued in relation to governmentapproved projects.

This Advisory shall have retroactive effect insofar as it does not prejudice or impair vested or acquired rights and shall take effect immediately after its publication once in a newspaper of general circulation and valid until 31 May 2025, or until sooner revoked.
