- The direct supplier bids shall be considered as fixed prices and not subject to escalation during contract implementation.
- The direct supplier shall replace the defective items within seven (7) days upon receipt of notification of the defect with the same quality and specifications at no cost to MARINA.
- 5. A warranty security shall be required from the contract awardee which shall be covered by either retention money in an amount equivalent to at least one percent (1%) but to not exceed five percent (5%) of every progress payment or a special bank guarantee equivalent to at least one percent (1%) of the total contract price pursuant to Section 62 of the 2016 Revised IRR of Republic Act No. 9184, for a minimum period of at least three (3) months after acceptance of the delivered supplies in order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the supplier. The said amount shall only be released after lapse of the warranty period. Provided, however, that the items delivered are free from patent and latent defects and all the conditions imposed under the contract have been fully met.

## **Liquidating Damage**

MARINA shall impose a penalty of 1/10 of 1% of the total value of the undelivered good/s or item/s for each day of delay as liquidated damages after specified allowable number of days to deliver the good/s or item/s.

## Inspection, Testing and Acceptance

The delivered good/s or item/s shall be subjected to visual and functional inspection and testing, acceptance and parameters such as, but not limited to:

- Quantity per item/goods
- Compliance to standard specifications per item

## **Right of MARINA**

MARINA shall have the right to reject, not to accept, or receive and return any good/s or item/s and cancel the corresponding contract if the units are found to be defective, incomplete, or non-compliant to the specifications herein specified.

Delivery Terms (to be determined by the End-User) Full delivery (100%) within thirty (30) working days upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed, to be delivered to the MARINA Building, 20th Street corner Bonifacio Drive, Port Area, Manila; and Delivery should be made within office hours and on regular working days on or before the stipulated date in the contract

unless otherwise specified for a valid reason why the scannot be complied with.
