Invitation to Foreign Suppliers, Manufacturers or Contractors to Submit Manifestation of Intention to Participate for the Project:

## Procurement of Seafarer's Identity Document (SID) Cards and Consumables

- 1. The Maritime Industry Authority, through the F.Y. 2025 General Appropriation Act, intends to apply the sum of Fifty-Five Million Two Hundred Forty-Four Thousand Pesos (Php 55,244,000.00), inclusive of VAT and other applicable government taxes, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the Project, "Procurement of Seafarer's Identity Document (SID) Cards and Consumables" through Direct Contracting under Section 50 (c) of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
- 2. Delivery of the Goods is required and must be in accordance with the Technical Specifications provided in Annex A.
- 3. In accordance with item 6.1 of Appendix 9 (Guidelines in the Determination of Eligibility of Foreign Suppliers, Contractors, and Consultants to Participate in Government Procurement Projects) of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184, the Maritime Industry Authority now invites foreign suppliers, manufacturers or contractors to submit manifestation of intention to participate on or before 12.NN of 27 November 2024. The manifestations must be sent and duly received by the BAC Secretariat through its official e-mail address at bacsec@marina.gov.ph.
- 4. If no foreign supplier, manufacturer or contractor submits such manifestation within the period stated above, the Maritime Industry Authority shall directly negotiate with the exclusive local distributor, in accordance with Section 50 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184 and Annex H (Consolidated Guidelines for the Alternative Methods of Procurement) of the same IRR.
- 5. This procurement project is undertaken through Early Procurement Activities (EPA), hence, the award of contract to the Lowest/Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder may only be made by the Procuring Entity upon approval or enactment of the FY 2025 General Appropriations Act (GAA) pursuant to Section 7.6 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act (RA) 9184 and the provisions under GPPB Circular 06-2019 dated July 17, 2019.
