SUBJECT : TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF MARINA MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. GC-2026-01 IN LIGHT OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 110

In view of the declaration of a National Emergency under Executive Order No. 110, and in order to mitigate the economic impact on the public and ensure the continued accessibility of essential maritime transport services, the implementation of MARINA Memorandum Circular No. GC-2026-01, particularly on the imposition of fees and charges, is hereby **TEMPORARILY SUSPENDED**.

Accordingly, all concerned MARINA Central and Regional Offices, are hereby directed to cease and desist from implementing and collecting the fees and charges prescribed under MARINA Memorandum Circular No. 2026-01 during the period of suspension.

During this period, the collection of fees and charges by MARINA shall be governed by the immediately preceding applicable MARINA issuances, rules, and regulations, including existing schedules of fees that remain valid and effective prior to the implementation of Memorandum Circular No. GC- 2026-01.

This suspension shall take effect immediately upon issuance of this Advisory and shall remain in force until lifted or modified by subsequent issuance, or until the cessation of the National Emergency, whichever comes first.
