**SUBJECT : THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ADVISORY ON THE CONTINGENCY
MEASURES TO ADDRESS THE IMPACT OF THE MIDDLE
EAST CRISIS TO THE PHILIPPINE MARITIME INDUSTRY**

In line with the directive of the Department of Transportation (DOTr) through their Memorandum dated 06 May 2026 and in accordance with the intervention powers of the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA) under Republic Act (RA) No. 9295 (Section 10.12), this third supplemental Advisory is hereby issued as contingency measure amid the volatile global fuel costs and state of national energy emergency.

1. The maximum 40% Required Rate Adjustment (RRA) under MARINA Advisory No. 2026-17 is hereby lowered down to **30%**, following the downward adjustment of fuel costs for the past three (3) consecutive weeks per the Department of Energy (DOE) Oil Monitor Advisories. The maximum 30% shall be based on the published rate indicated in the Certificate of Public Convenience (CPC) of the domestic shipping companies and operators as of 28 February 2026.
2. The transport of agricultural products and basic/critical commodities shall continue to be given priority and revert to the freight rates as of **28 February 2026 before the fuel crisis**.
3. All other provisions of **MARINA Advisory (MA) Nos. 2026-10, 2026-15, and 2026-17** not inconsistent herewith shall remain in effect.

This Advisory shall take effect immediately.
